

With the goal of raising \$600,000 for the maintenance and improvement of our church, this Campaign is relying on the generosity of each of our parishioners. MAINTENANCE & RENOVATIONS IN DETAIL




The funds raised from this Capital Campaign will be allocated to meet multiple areas of needs, as well as proposals for improvements to our church. While some of the projects detailed below are able to be started as early as Fall 2019, many are best addressed during the same timeframe, to ensure greater cost effectiveness and limit interruption to the celebration of the sacraments in the main church space. MAINTENANCE UPGRADES

- Repairing the plumbing, septic & perimeter drainage, as well as door & window seals
- Installing HVAC controls
- Replacing the shingled roof in the connector
- Repairing the perimeter drainage system
- Upgrading the church’s security systems
- Repairing the Northeast stained glass windows
- Purchasing new furnishings for classrooms
- Replacing the drop ceiling the chapel area
- Updating lighting through the church
- Expanding parking at the handicap entrance, as well as at senior parking at the front of church

RENOVATION PROJECTS

- Replacing the sanctuary carpet to reduce potential tripping hazards & improve the look and feel of the church.
- Repairing or replacing the existing pews to address wear and tear, consideration of padding some or all of the pews, as well as upgrading the existing kneelers to increase usability.
- Expose the existing, natural-wood ceiling in the main sanctuary to enhance the overall character of the church and save on future maintenance costs associated with the current ceiling.
