



Also, for better communication for the Bible Timeline Study, we will be using **Remind**. With Remind, you choose how you want to be notified – text, email, or push notifications (requires the phone app). You can update or cancel each “class” you sign up for at any time. Use one of the following methods below or notify the parish office to get signed up.

- 1) Text Messages:
 - a. Text “@hrBible” to 81010
 - b. You will receive follow-up messages from Remind, please complete all steps.
- 2) Push Notifications:
 - a. Download the Remind App from Android or iOS or go to rmd.me/a to install.
 - b. Once app is downloaded, create parent account with your email address.
 - c. Go to the classes tab, tap the +, enter “hrBible” and follow prompts.
- 3) Email Messages:
 - a. Go to www.remind.com and sign up for an account (if didn’t use 1 or 2)
 - b. Search for “hrBible” or find the school “Holy Redeemer Catholic Church” and sign up for the class “hrBible”.
 - c. Add your email address for use for messages.
- 4) If problems with any of the above, please call the parish office and we can get you signed up. We will just need your email address and/or cell# depending on what form of communication you want to use.
