### Worship & Spirituality/Liturgy/Sacraments → Ministry of Sanctification:

- Adult Choir** sings on various Sundays and major feast days; rehearsals are on Wednesday evenings at 7:00
- Adult Servers** enhance the parish's worship, particularly at daytime funeral masses and morning holidays
- Arts & Design** works on the various decorative changes needed with the liturgical year including care of plants inside of church
- Baptism Preparation** offers an opportunity to meet other parents to discuss the meaning and purpose of raising their child in the Catholic faith.
- Cantors** lead the psalm and other music at liturgical celebrations.
- Children's Liturgy of the Word** proclaim and discuss the Sunday scripture with children in grades K-5 during the 10am Sunday Mass. \_\_\_ Leader \_\_\_ Helper
- Eucharistic Adoration** takes place every Tuesday from 9 a.m. – 9 p.m. Volunteers sign up for shifts to pray for one hour each week.
- Eucharistic Ministers at Mass** serve God and their parish by ministering communion during Mass. \_\_\_ Weekday \_\_\_ Weekend (must have received Confirmation)
- Funeral Volunteers** help with any of the following at funeral Masses: \_\_\_ Lector \_\_\_ Server \_\_\_ Eucharistic Minister \_\_\_ Usher
- Greeters** greet regularly before all Masses. \_\_\_ Saturday \_\_\_ Sunday 8 \_\_\_ Sunday 10 \_\_\_ Any
- Instrumentalists** provide accompaniment with use of instruments (brass, drums, flute, violin, etc) as needed through the year. High school band members are welcome as well.
- Lectors** proclaim the Word of God at Masses. \_\_\_ Weekday \_\_\_ Weekend
- Liturgy Coordinators** help at weekend Masses to oversee the lectors, Eucharistic ministers, and servers
- Marriage Preparation/FOCCUS** Couples meet with engaged couples and aid them in discussing married life.
- Mass Servers** assist at the Eucharist by carrying candles in processions and help set the altar. Servers include youth in grades 4 through 12. (Name & grade of child) \_\_\_\_\_
- Men's Prayer Group** meets twice a month on Saturday mornings to discuss scripture and join in prayer
- Prayer Circle** prays for the needs of anyone requesting special prayers.
- Rosary leader** leads Rosary before Masses at weekday and weekend Masses. \_\_\_ Weekday \_\_\_ Weekend
- Sacristans** clean liturgical vessels and candles used during the Eucharist and clean linens and vestments. The group meets on Wednesday mornings or as needed. \_\_\_ linens \_\_\_ sanctuary
- Ushers** assist with the flow of parishioners, provide worship aids, arrange seating, take up the offering, assist at communion, and hand out bulletins. Currently looking for subs.

### Education → Ministry of Teaching:

- Adult Faith Formation** provides opportunities for ongoing educational and spiritual development of adults.
- Catechists** provide the faith formation to our youth by teaching CCD classes. \_\_\_ Regular \_\_\_ Sub
- Education Commission** works to assure opportunities for school age children to grow in their knowledge of the Catholic faith and in their desire to be disciples of Jesus. They meet four times a year.
- Vacation Bible School** event held in the summer for age 4 to grade 4. Help is needed on committee for planning, crew leaders, snacks, games, music, setup, family night, crafts, and cleanup.
- Youth Ministry** is offered to youth in grades 7-12 – meeting weekly throughout the school year. Retreats, events and activities are also offered. Adult chaperones are always welcome
- Young Adult Ministry** is a new group that promotes the ongoing educational and spiritual development of adult parishioners in their 20's and 30's.

## Evangelization & Service → Ministry of Serving:

- Bereavement Group** extends prayerful support to parishioners who have lost a loved one.
- Book Club** meets regularly (usually monthly) to discuss a variety of book genres.
- Busy Bakers** bake cookies and treats (and sometimes extra dishes for funerals) on an as needed basis.
- Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP)/Welcome** meet & pray together regularly and sponsors 2 retreats per year.
- Couple's Night Out** plan couple's events throughout the year.
- Donut Sunday** helps with donut Sunday once a month
- Eucharistic Ministers Outside of Mass** bring the Eucharist and the Word of God to parishioners.

- Evangelization & Service Commission** is responsible for shaping the parish's ministry to its own members and its outreach into the larger community by supporting a wide variety of outreach efforts.
- Funeral Lunch Group** orders and prepares food for after funeral celebrations.
- Knights of Columbus (KofC)** Men of faith from Minster, New Bremen, and Fort Loramie doing good works of Charity, Unity, and Fraternity.
- Loaves and Fishes** serve meals to approximately 200 people every other month at a free meal site in Wapakoneta. Help is needed in preparing food as well as serving on the scheduled day.
- Men's Night Out** plan men's night out and speakers.
- Women's Night Out** plan women's night out and mothers, daughters, sister, friend event
- Mission Team** is actively involved with three churches in Grenada.
- Nursery** is offered during the 10:00 a.m. Mass each week. Volunteers are needed weekly
- Parish Directory** a committee that forms every five years to assist in the compiling of the parish directory.
- Respect Life Group** works in conjunction with Minster to organize events that focus on life issues.
- Sharing Talents** volunteer to help parishioners in need of help around the house. – **NEW MINISTRY**
- Stephen Ministry** trained parishioners who provide one-to-one confidential, non-judgmental, Christian care to people in crisis or in need of care. – **NEW MINISTRY**
- Transportation (aka: The Friend Ship)** volunteer to drive parishioners as needed – **NEW MINISTRY**
- Welcoming Committee** is a group that reaches out to new families that join the parish.

## Other Committees and Ministries:

- Audio/Video Coordinators** record & live stream Masses and other events – **NEW MINISTRY**
- Finance Committee** reviews the financial statement of the parish, puts together the budget, and gives direction and advice to the Pastor and Pastoral Council on financial matters.
- Collection Counters** are needed after the 10:00 Mass each week to count the weekly collection.
- Digital Disciples** manage all things 'techie' including the parish website, social media, and communications.
- Flowers and Gardening** helps with the beautification of plants and flowers outside of church and helps in the parish gardens.
- Property Committee** oversees the physical condition of the parish buildings, land, and equipment. They aid in the short and long-term needs for maintenance, replacement, and expansion.
