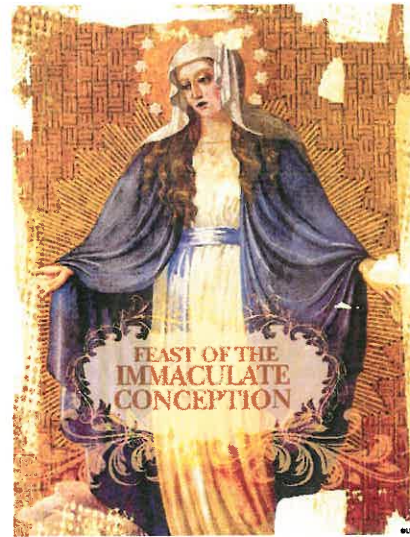

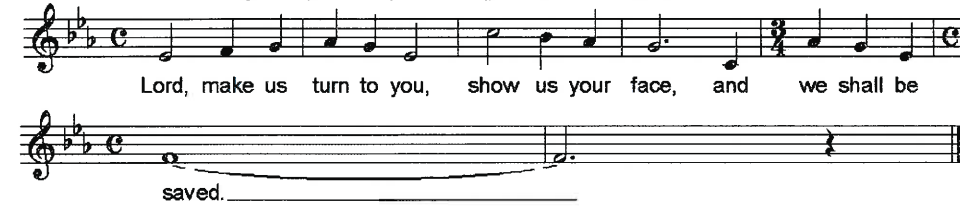

This year our parish is blessed with a new Advent Wreath. The concluding prayer of the petitions will be a blessing prayer for our new wreath.

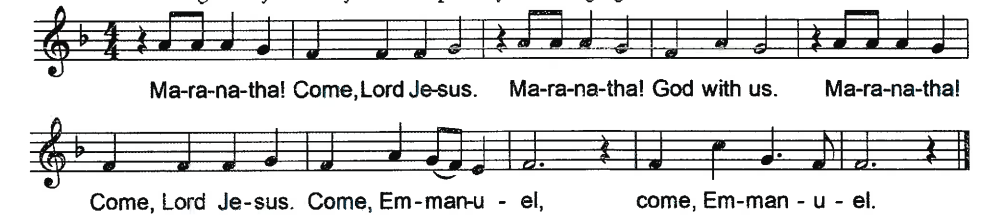

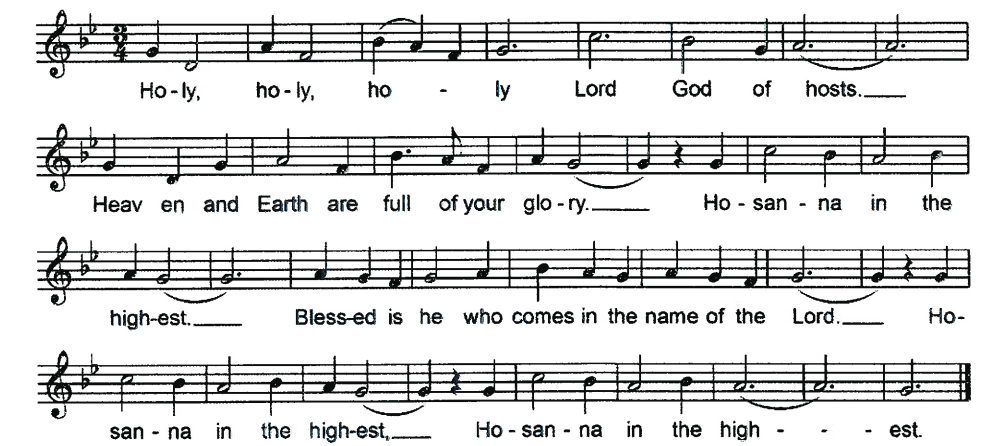

Mass of Creation



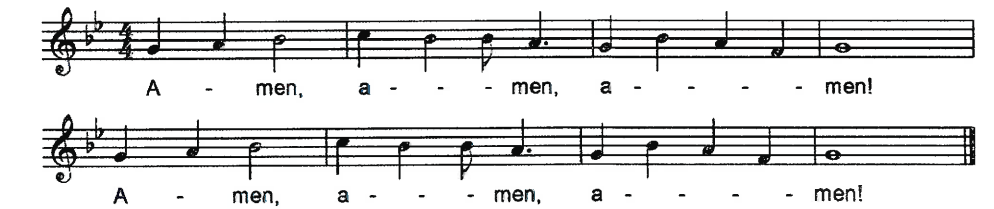
