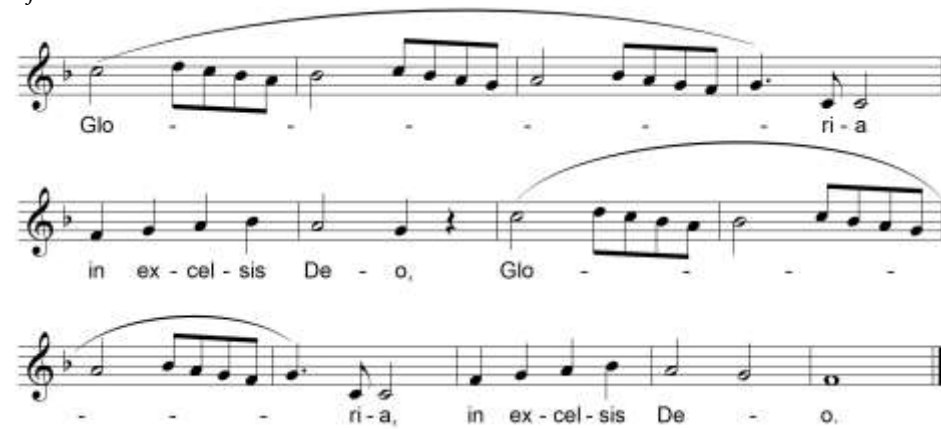


Gloria

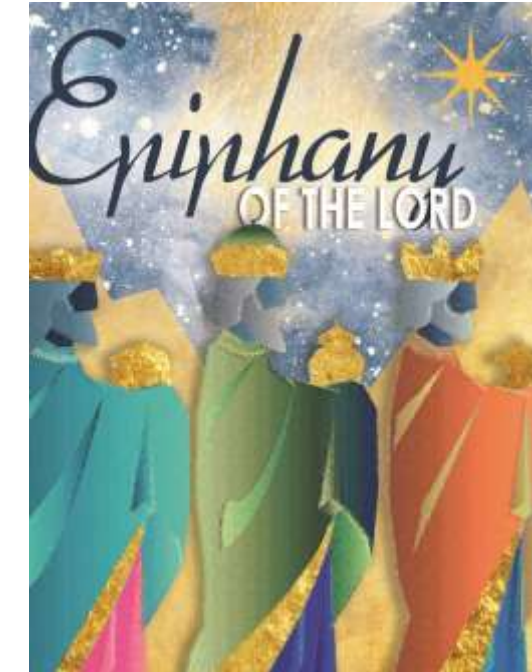
