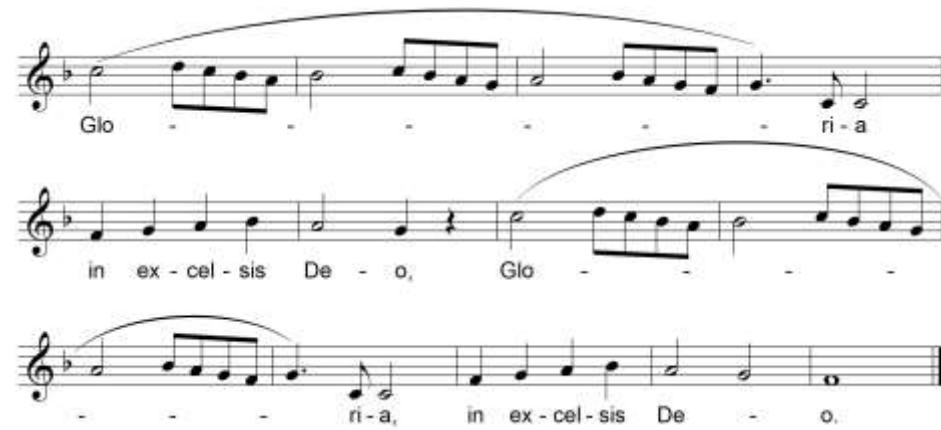


Gloria
