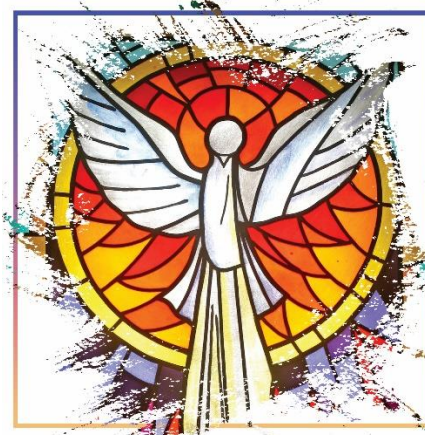

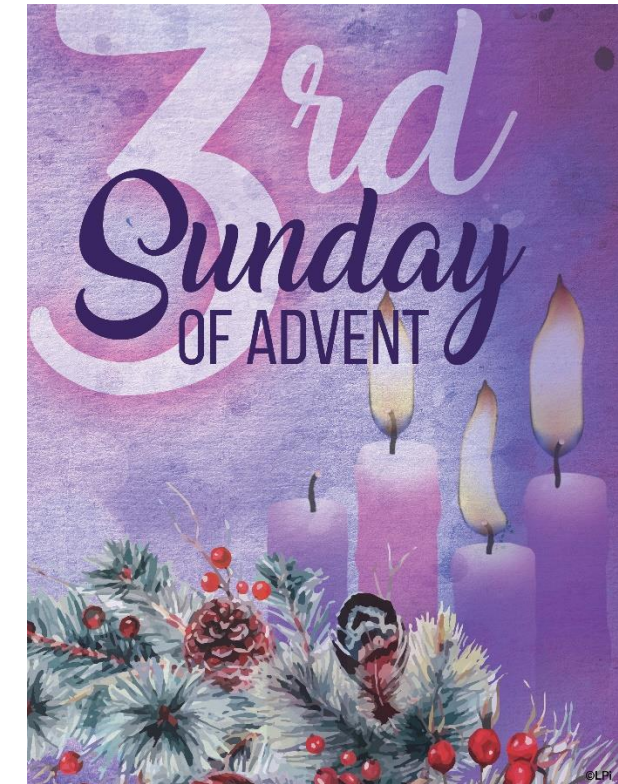
Please note that there will be no 4:30pm Mass on Christmas Day.
